

CANEY FORK ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC.

Application for Membership and Electric Service

I/We (hereinafter called "Applicant(s)") hereby apply for membership in and agree to purchase electric energy from CANEY FORK ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. (hereinafter called "Cooperative") to be supplied at any address where service is available in the Cooperative area.

The Applicant agrees to pay for said services as bills are rendered therefore in accordance with the Bylaws of the Cooperative, Rules and Regulations as may be adopted from time to time by the Cooperative and rates in effect at the time of the delivery of electric energy.

The Applicant agrees when electric service becomes available, that substantially all electric energy used on the premises will be purchased from the Cooperative and will be paid for at rates currently in effect or as amended from time to time provided, however, that the Cooperative may limit the consumption of energy which it shall be required to furnish the Applicant.

The Applicant agrees to (a) make payment of such membership fee as required by the Cooperative Bylaws, their amendments and/or Rules and Regulations in respect to membership and (b) make such deposits with the Cooperative as may be required by the Cooperative's Rules and Regulations and Policy. It is expressly understood that the Applicant further agrees to pay all indebtedness for service rendered, and in event of a delinquent account, shall pay reasonable expense of collection, legal, court costs, attorney fees and otherwise.

The Applicant, by becoming a member, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for debts or liabilities of Cooperative, and it is expressly understood that, under law, his private property cannot be attached for any such debts or liabilities.

In compliance with the Cooperative's bylaws, it is understood and agreed to by the Applicant(s) that a portion of the equity accruing to him/her/them each year will be used for one year's subscription to the "Tennessee Magazine", the amount not to exceed the actual cost to the Cooperative. The remaining equity may be used for capital improvements to the Cooperative.

In consideration of the benefits derived, and as further inducement for the acceptance of this application, I hereby grant to Caney Fork Electric Cooperative, Inc., its successors and assigns an easement with the right to enter upon on all real property which I own or in which I have an interest, and to place, construct, repair, maintain, replace or relocate thereon, poles, electrical appurtenances electrical transmission lines, distribution lines, and/or service lines, and do all acts necessary in said construction, maintenance or repairing of said lines, poles and appurtenances, including the locations of poles, trimming, cutting and/or spraying of trees/vegetation, or removal of any obstacle that might, in the discretion of the Cooperative, become an object of interference in the building or maintenance of said electrical poles, lines, or appurtenances. I covenant and warrant that I am seized and possessed of this land and have a right to convey an easement thereon.
